

Environmental Policy

At Turnkey Aftercare Ltd, we recognise our responsibility to minimise the environmental impact of our operations. We are committed to conducting our work in a way that supports sustainability and reduces waste wherever possible.



Waste Management and Disposal

- All waste generated during remedial works – including used mastic tubes, empty paint tins, expansion foam canisters, and similar materials – will be collected and removed from site by our team.
- These materials will be taken to licensed recycling centres or appropriate disposal facilities, in line with local authority and environmental regulations.
- We ensure that no waste is left on site and aim to recycle materials wherever suitable facilities exist.

Hazardous Materials

- Turnkey Aftercare does not handle, remove, or dispose of hazardous materials such as asbestos or chemicals classified under hazardous waste regulations.
- If such materials are encountered, the client will be notified immediately, and specialist contractors will be recommended.

Reducing Environmental Impact

- We aim to minimise packaging waste and single-use items on all jobs.
- Wherever possible, we use products and materials with lower environmental impact and source from responsible suppliers.
- All staff are encouraged to work efficiently, reduce vehicle emissions by planning routes carefully, and keep unnecessary engine idling to a minimum.
